**Grosberg Family Judaic Studies/Hebrew Teachers' Award - Guidelines**

**\$5,000 awarded annually to a Judaic Studies/Hebrew teacher for study that leads to enhancing the Judaic Studies/Hebrew curriculum of the school or the teaching practice of the teacher.**

1. Recipient will be a Judaic Studies/Hebrew teacher at an approved and recognized school in Winnipeg.
2. The award will be towards study in a post-graduate program or recognized and approved program in Judaic Studies/Hebrew that leads to enhancing the Judaic Studies/Hebrew curriculum of the school or the teaching practice of the teacher.
3. The teacher must continue to teach in Judaic Studies/Hebrew at his/her school for a period of two (2) years after receipt of this award.
4. If the teacher chooses to leave his/her employment immediately after the course of study, the award must be returned in full.
5. If the teacher chooses to leave his/her employment within one year after the course of study, fifty (50) percent of the award must be returned.
6. Written proof of acceptance prior to payment in a recognized and approved Judaic studies/Hebrew program must be submitted to the Jewish Foundation of Manitoba. As well, the applicant will provide sufficient background information to establish the veracity of the intended program of studies.
7. A written agreement between the Jewish Foundation of Manitoba and the recipient must be completed prior to the award being announced and monies forwarded.

**Note:** The Scholarship Committee, at its discretion, may distribute two awards of \$2,500, instead of one award of \$5,000, depending on applications received.
