SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

SHARON HOME FAMILY EDUCATION AWARD

Deadline – February 28

\$1,000 per year awarded to one recipient *

Friends of the Sharon Home established this award to help children/dependents of long-service employees of the Sharon Home to pursue post-secondary education. The award is based on financial need, academic achievement and community involvement.

To be eligible for the Sharon Home Family Education Award, an applicant:

- Must be a child or dependent of a “long service employee” of the Sharon Home. A “long service employee” is considered a full or part-time employee who has 10 or more years of service as at January 1st of the year of application
- Must be 25 years of age or LESS (25th birthday must be subsequent to January 1st of the year of application)
- Must be applying for, have been accepted into, or be continuing studies in a university, college or other post-graduate program with preference given to persons studying at a Manitoba educational institution
- Must not have previously received the Sharon Home Family Education Award

Assuming the applicant meets the eligibility requirements set forth above, the following criteria will be used by the selection committee in recommending an award:

- Financial need
- Academic achievement
- Community participation or volunteer activity
