SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

RUTH & JOE FREED AND STEPHEN FREED AND FAMILY ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AWARDS

DEADLINE – MAY 15TH *

Awarded to Jewish students who have excelled academically in university or college studies, and who have demonstrated a commitment to the Jewish community. These awards are based on academic achievement and community involvement with no financial need component.

To be eligible for a Ruth & Joe Freed and Stephen Freed and Family Academic Excellence Award, an applicant:

A QUALIFIED CANDIDATE WILL...

- ...be Jewish
- ... have completed or are completing a year of university/college within the current calendar year
- ... not have previously received a 'Ruth & Joe Freed and Stephen Freed and Family Academic Excellence Award'
- ...Must not have received an Education Award from the Jewish Foundation of Manitoba during
 - the current school year

Assuming the applicant meets the eligibility requirements set forth above, the following criteria will be used by the selection committee in recommending an award:

- Consistent excellence in academic achievement
- Demonstrated commitment to the Jewish community
- Volunteer work in the Jewish community
- Volunteer work in the local community

* The deadline for this award is May 15th, however the applications will not be considered until final marks for the current academic year have been received.
