SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

IRMA PENN IMO MARVIN PENN EDUCATIONAL AWARD

DEADLINE – FEBRUARY 28th \$7,500 PER YEAR AWARDED TO TWO STUDENTS*

Two awards shall be awarded to Jewish students in Manitoba.

Applicants may either be teachers in the Jewish educational or Hebrew Bilingual school system who are enrolled or entering a post-graduate program with the intent of furthering their professional development or students entering or enrolled in a post-secondary degree program and taking Judaic Studies courses.

Consideration shall be given to students studying in Israel.

This award is based on academic achievement, community involvement and professional experience.

Financial need is not a consideration.

A QUALIFIED CANDIDATE WILL...

- ... be Jewish
- ... be a resident of Manitoba
- ... be a full-time, part-time, or summer student
- ... be studying in Manitoba or working in a Jewish educational or Hebrew Bilingual setting in Manitoba

Assuming the applicant meets the eligibility requirements set forth above, the following criteria will be used by the selection committee in recommending an award:

- Academic Achievement
- Volunteer work in the Jewish community
- Volunteer work in the local community
- Professional Experience

* The Jewish Foundation of Manitoba reserves the right not to award these scholarships on an annual basis. This is dependent upon the receipt of qualified applications as determined by the terms and conditions of the scholarship.

The Jewish Foundation of Manitoba reserves the right to distribute the award over the course of five years to recipients studying part-time.
