



SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

SAUL & CLARIBEL SIMKIN CENTRE FAMILY EDUCATION AWARD

Deadline – February 28th | \$4,500 per year awarded to one recipient *

Friends of the Saul & Claribel Simkin Centre established this award to help children/dependents of long-service employees to pursue post-secondary education. The award is based on financial need, academic achievement and community involvement.

To be eligible for the Saul & Claribel Simkin Centre Family Education Award, an applicant:

A QUALIFIED CANDIDATE WILL...

- ...be a child or dependent of a 'long service employee' of the Centre. A 'long service employee' is considered a full or part-time employee who has 5 or more years of service as at January 1st of the year of application
- ...be 25 years of age or less (25th birthday must be subsequent to January 1st of the year of application)
- ...be applying for, have been accepted into, or be continuing studies in a university, college or other post-graduate program with preference given to persons studying at a Manitoba educational institution
- ...not have previously received the Saul & Claribel Simkin Centre Family Education Award unless the award was not given out during the previous calendar year **
- ... must be a resident of Manitoba

Assuming the applicant meets the eligibility requirements set forth above, the following criteria will be used by the selection committee in recommending an award:

- Financial need
- Academic achievement
- Community participation or volunteer activity
